HIERARCHY OF LEGAL INSTRUMENTS ON INTERNATIONAL JUDICIAL COOPERATION (the case with Bosnia and Herzegovina)

Summary: The article deals with the legal force of domestic law and international agreements on international judicial cooperation in cases of conflict between them. The hierarchy of such legal instruments is established by statutory provisions or comes as a result of some appropriate choice. Although international law has developed as a horizontal system of norms, the existence of hierarchically superior norms overriding others is a must when it comes to governing international judicial cooperation.
